1. PROJECTS

Camalaniugan National High School, Catotoran Annex - Classroom

After two years of finding the right project and half a year of getting it done, the construction of the IT classroom at Camalaniugan National High School – Catotoran Annex in the province of Cagayan was finally completed in July 2018. The inauguration was witnessed by Lasten Tulevaisuus (represented by Evangeline Cabal and Concepcion Aquino), representatives of *Akbay Kapatid* Foundation (AKF), with whom we partnered to oversee the construction, The Parents and Teacher’s Association, town officials, teachers and students. The inauguration was highlighted with the local parish priest’s blessing, entertainment by the students and the ribbon cutting of the plaque.

The first payment of ~5.900,00 euros was transferred during the previous period and the second payment of ~3.700,00 euros during this period. There is still an amount remaining from the donation of 12.200,00 euros by Åland Friends for this project. The remaining amount will cover the other needs for the classroom and possible maintenance costs that will be discussed further with AKF.





Children's Scholarship Program (CSP) of Samaritana Transformation Ministries

For the school year 2018-2019, the association gave financial support of about 2.300,00 euros for 19 students – 7 high school, 11 elementary and 1 college. The support was for matriculation fees, uniforms and shoes, school bags and supplies, private tutoring if necessary, home and school visits, field trips and camps, medical and dental checkups; transportation of mothers and children for monthly meetings and counseling; and miscellaneous costs. We have supported Samaritana since 2007.

Margaret Aguila-Jaakola visited Samaritana in September 2019 and met with some of the mothers and children scholars.

2. EVENTS

Maailma kylässä (World Village Festival), May 26 and 27, 2018

The gross sales in 2018 was about 6.300,00, a little more than the previous year. This yearly event has still been the most significant fundraiser for the association since 2008.

Note: Cash donations for *Maailma kylässä* (World Village Festival) were recorded in the books under *Tapahtumat* (Events) and not under *Lahjoitukset* (Donations).

3. MEETINGS

Annual meeting

The statutory annual general meeting was held on 12.05.2018 in Helsinki. Approved during the said meeting were the following:

- a. annual report and financial statements of the previous financial period;
- b. discharging of the outgoing Board from liability of accounts;
- c. annual membership fee of Euros 20; and
- d. the plan of actions and budget for the financial period.

In addition, an amendment to the articles of association was approved by the body.
